Background

The Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM) strives to strengthen the capacities of universities to foster innovations responsive to demands of smallholder farmers in Africa. This is achieved through Secretariat coordinated programs and guided by virtual and physical networking including convening events such as the Annual General Meeting (AGM) and associated side events. The AGM is preceded by constitutional meetings of all RUFORUM Governance Organs as well as side events designed to inculcate cross-cutting skills unto students; and, share and learn from member universities, policy makers and key stakeholders in higher education and agricultural development. This year's AGM will also serve as a catalyst for leveraging resources and foster mutually beneficial partnerships among universities in and outside the Network as well as with other stakeholders. In addition to its Business Meeting on 16th December 2022, the AGM will reflect on the first Operational Plan (2018-2022). Its Vision 2030 sought to attract and nurture (through the transformative process of learning and knowledge accumulation) a superior new generation of scientists and development practitioners to spur significant economies of scope and scale with a focus on agricultural transformation in Africa with the generation of technologies and innovations for broad development in the continent. The Closing Ceremony will culminate by recognising Outstanding Farmers, Young Scientists, and Young Innovators and Entrepreneurs. The awards reflect RUFORUM's perspective that enhancing the capacity to manage change amidst a myriad of problems requires a new cadre of change agents capable of visioning, strategizing, empathizing, mobilizing, training and empowering people to take charge of their destiny. These are the "proactive graduates" Africa needs to drive the Africa Union Agenda 2063 (The Africa We Want). Additionally, this event will appreciate the efforts undertaken by the Outgoing RUFORUM Executive Secretary in "catalysing development change in Africa and globally by building capacity of African people and its institutions, to positively contribute to change prosperity", and introduce the New RUFORUM Executive Secretary.
