Introduction

The Exhibitions at the RUFORUM AGM present a great opportunity to all RUFORUM stakeholders to showcase cutting edge innovations, products, entrepreneurship skills and services. The RUFORUM AGM also presents an opportunity to share research and innovative interventions in the Agricultural and Higher Education sectors.

In addition to the exhibitions, there will be dedicated Poster Sessions that will feature discourse on topical issues in line with the overall AGM theme and sub-themes. The Poster sessions provide a snapshot of the key developments and challenges in higher agricultural education. This year's exhibition will focus on products and services in Cameroon as part of RUFORUM's role in Country profiling.

- 3. Prior to the conference, all interested exhibitors will be requested by the RUFORUM Secretariat coordination team to provide a profile of their exhibitions using a given template. This aims at profiling the exhibiting institutions.
