#### Background

The Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM), a consortium of 163 universities in 40 African countries hosts its 19<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting in Yaounde, Cameroon from 28<sup>th</sup> October to 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2023. This is the first time the AGM is being held in Central Africa and provides an opportunity for stakeholders in agriculture and higher education to share experiences and chart a way forward for transforming higher agricultural and tertiary education to contribute to sustainable development in Africa. The overall theme of the 19<sup>th</sup> RUFORUM AGM is to deliberate on "*Transforming Higher Education to Sustainably Feed and Create Prosperity for Africa*".

The meeting will bring together over 600 delegates from across Africa and beyond, under the patronage of His Excellency Paul Biya, President of the Republic of Cameroon, Ministers, African Union Commission, Development Partners, University leaders, students, private sector leaders; farmers and farmer representatives; emerging & early career researchers and other key stakeholders.

After five days of intense activity, a closing ceremony is planned for the afternoon of November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2023 from 14:00 to 16:00 hours. During the closing ceremony, participants will reflect on the five-day congress, receive a synthesis of the meeting outcomes, takeaway messages and action points that will guide strategy and operations during the coming year. In line with the conference theme, the following activities will be conducted:

a) Evaluation of the relevance and competencies attained from the trainings and other preconference events to inform future capacity development interventions of the RUFORUM Network and the African continent.

- b) Strategic investment areas and partnership opportunities for human capital development, resourcing, research for development required to sustainably feed and create prosperity for Africa
- c) Communication of key decisions on transforming and financing novel higher education models that produce human resources, technologies and innovations,
- d) Communication of key decisions of the RUFORUM Governance for enhancing the performance and functionality of the RUFORUM Network, and
- e) Action points for RUFORUM and partners present in implementing the resolutions made from each of the sessions to catalyse and support the transformation of African higher education.
