Background

The Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM) is 163-member pan African organisation founded in 2004 by Vice Chancellors whose membership is found in 40 countries (for details see www.ruforum.org). The Network serves a number of purposes:

- Strategic solidarity support to members by building capacity for each other within Africa;
- Resource mobilisation and rationalisation for efficient and effective human capital development and research;
- Strategic capacity strengthening initiatives for university leaders, future teachers and lecturers as well as researchers and development practitioners;
- Supportive transformative education agenda to place African institutions at the forefront of producing graduates who meet the future of work qualities
- Enhance university engagement in policy, research and development processes and practice.

The RUFORUM Network meets annually to review progress and share experiences with its members and other education ecosystem actors from which guidance and new thrusts are drawn. There are a number of mutually reinforcing meetings that are held in that regard by RUFORUM governance organs, policy agencies, science community as well as education and research partners from the Global South and Global North. The central meeting is the Annual General Meeting, the supreme decision-making organ of the RUFORUM Network. Member universities hold the annual General Meeting on a rotational basis. This year's AGM is hosted by The University of Bamenda, The University of Buea, The University of Dschang, The University of Maroua, and The University of Ngaoundere. The business meeting during the AGM will be held on 2nd November, 2023 at Inaugural Hall, Palais des Congrès, Yaoundé, Cameroon.
